MEDIA ADVISORY: State-Run Testing Sites Operating Tomorrow

Baltimore, MD – The Maryland Department of Health (MDH), in partnership with hospitals statewide and the Maryland National Guard, is opening or expanding the hours of operation at COVID-19 testing sites across the state, as <u>announced</u> by Governor Hogan on Jan. 4.

The following new and expanded sites will be open tomorrow, Wednesday, Jan. 12, for free walk-up or drive-through COVID-19 testing without an appointment.
