The Childhood Lead Prevention Project ECHO® is a new six-month, quality improvement, MOC part 4* program. Focusing on central New Jersey counties (Hunterdon, Mercer, Middlesex, Monmouth, Somerset, and Union), this program aims to improve early identification and referral of children with elevated blood lead levels to reduce the incidence of developmental disabilities in NJ children.
