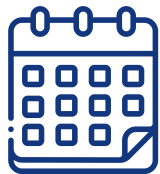


# CHILDHOOD LEAD PREVENTION PROJECT ECHO®

The Childhood Lead Prevention Project ECHO® is a new six-month, quality improvement, MOC part 4\* program. Focusing on central New Jersey counties (Hunterdon, Mercer, Middlesex, Monmouth, Somerset, and Union), this program aims to improve early identification and referral of children with elevated blood lead levels to reduce the incidence of developmental disabilities in NJ children.

Launching in January 2023, this program will feature:



Monthly sessions on the third Wednesday of the month 12-1PM



Mentoring and guidance from multi-disciplinary hub faculty



Quality improvement coaching



Progress tracking through personalized run charts



Monthly data submissions



Case-based and peer-to-peer learning
