Apple Health and Homes Rental Assistance Program (AHAH-RAP) eligibility

To be eligible for AHAH-RAP, enrollees need to meet all the following criteria:

- ☐ 18 years or older
- ☐ Medicaid eligible
- ☐ Enrolled in Foundational Community Supports Supportive Housing (FCS-SH) services under one of these risk factors:
 - Chronic homelessness
 - Frequent or lengthy institutional contacts
 - Frequent adult residential care stays
- ☐ Experiencing homelessness:
 - Per [RCW 43.185C.010 \(wa.gov\)](#), *homeless person* means an individual living outside or in a building not meant for human habitation or in which they have no legal right to occupy, in an emergency shelter, or in a temporary housing program that may include a transitional and supportive housing program if habitation time limits exist.

How you can help enrollees receive rental assistance

If all criteria are met, FCS-SH providers should complete the AHAH-RAP portion of the **FCS Supportive Housing Assessment** with the enrollee to be entered into a drawing for a chance to receive rental assistance through the Department of Commerce Office of AHAH. If the enrollee is selected to receive an AHAH-RAP voucher, we will notify them and their FCS-SH provider. Then the FCS-SH provider should help the awardee complete and submit the AHAH awardee profile to us.
