Apple Health and Homes Rental Assistance Program (AHAH-RAP) eligibility

Each box must be met for eligibility in AHAH-RAP:

- 18 years or older
- Medicaid eligible
- Enrolled in foundational community supports supportive housing (FCS-SH) services under one of these risk factors:
 - Chronic homelessness
 - Frequent or lengthy institutional contacts
 - Frequent adult residential care stays
- Experiencing homelessness:
Per [RCW 43.185C.010](#), *homeless person* means an individual living outside or in a building not meant for human habitation or which they have no legal right to occupy, in an emergency shelter, or in a temporary housing program which may include a transitional and supportive housing program if habitation time limits exist.

If all four boxes are met, submit an [AHAH Assessment](#) to be entered into a drawing for a chance to receive rental assistance through the Department of Commerce Office of AHAH. Submit an [AHAH Assessment](#) to Wellpoint via the link on the FCS provider website (<http://tinyurl.com/5bc7wdpp>), under the *Apple Health and Homes (AHAH)* section.

If selected to receive rental assistance, Wellpoint will notify the AHAH awardee and their FCS-SH provider. The FCS-SH provider will work with the AHAH awardee to submit the AHAH [Awardee Profile](#) to Wellpoint via the link on the FCS provider website, (<http://tinyurl.com/5bc7wdpp>), under the *Apple Health and Homes (AHAH)* section.
